This course gives individuals a range of factual, technical and procedural knowledge of provide assistance to health professional staff for the care of patients.

This includes direct patient contact under supervision, supervise and coordinate a small team, clinical cleaning, food preparation and distribution, patient transport, assisting with movement, inventory, waste handling, handling of medical gas cylinders and MET calls.

Competency is assessed through a combination of practical application and demonstration of skills, research, analysis and completion of competency based workbooks.

## Practical Experience and Assessment

Students get the opportunity to undertake practical skill development throughout the course in the All Health Training simulated environment with trainers who are experts in their field and maintain currency in the industry. Students are also assessed based on skill development throughout the course in addition to 80 hours of practical placement.

## Opportunity for Credit Transfers (CT) + Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

If students have already successfully completed unit/s of competency which are included within the current listing qualification AHT offers, credit transfers may be granted. Competencies gained through other formal study or experience may be acknowledged through a Recognition of Prior Learning Process.

## Further Education

For career advancement, consider pursuing higher-level qualifications like the Certificate III in Pathology Collection, Diploma of Nursing or Certificate IV in Allied Health Assistance. These qualifications can open doors to other roles within the healthcare sector.
